Parent Policy Information

Thank you for enrolling your child for the **Play For Sport** team! We are excited about working with your child to introduce them to the world of sports and to help them improve their skills in sports they may have already begun. Below are our policies regarding payments, missed classes, class attire, etc. Please feel free to contact us in the event you have any questions regarding our class curriculum and/or your child's participation. Please watch for weekly handouts that include tips for the players as well as their parents.

- **Payment is due by the first class of each month.** Please make your payment online or make checks payable to Play For Sport and drop them off in the Play For Sport payment box or with your childcare office. Please write your child's name in the memo section of your check. **There will be a \$25 return fee for all return checks.** You may also visit our website to make payments online and to enroll in automatic billing. Be sure to select the proper location where your child attends school so your payment will be properly received at www.playforsport.com.
- You will receive a friendly reminder if tuition is not received by the first class of the month. If tuition is not received by the 10th, a late fee of \$5 will be applied.
- Play For Sport's tuition fees are based on four-week months. During months with five weeks, classes will not be held during the fifth week unless otherwise specified.
- Monthly payments are made to Play For Sport regardless of your child's attendance. If you are planning for your child to be away from school for an extended period of time, please notify us in ***advance*** and tuition will be prorated for your convenience.
- To withdraw your child, you must call, e-mail our office, or leave a written notice in the Play For Sport tuition box or with your school's director. If you fail to notify us directly, billing will continue to accrue for which you will be responsible.
- Please be courteous and provide us with a two-week notice if you plan to remove your child from the Play For Sport team. Class sizes are limited and waiting lists are common. You may do so by phone, email, or leaving a written notice with the school's director.
- **Children should be dressed for action!** This attire includes loose fitting clothing and athletic shoes. Dresses, skirts, flip flops, boots, or sandals inhibit movement and can make it difficult to maintain footing during action oriented drills.
